

SB 149 (McGuire, D-Healdsburg) would prohibit the Secretary of State from printing the name of a candidate for President of the United States on a primary election ballot, unless the candidate discloses his or her IRS tax returns.

Republican Senator Joel Anderson proposed amendments to SB 149 that would have applied this same standard to candidates for statewide and legislative office.
